

Information about Camera Surveillance

Purpose of Camera Surveillance

Stiftelsen Stockholms studentbostäder, reg. no. 802003–2887 (“Stockholms studentbostäder”), uses camera surveillance to prevent and detect criminal acts within the properties where Stockholms studentbostäder operates, as well as to protect employees, tenants, and visitors from crime and accidents.

The purpose is to maintain a safe environment for tenants, and to prevent and investigate incidents such as unauthorized access, burglary, and vandalism. Camera surveillance serves as support in our preventive work against serious incidents that pose a threat to persons or property, as well as in the investigation of crimes such as vandalism, theft, or threats and violence.

Legal Basis

Camera surveillance is carried out in accordance with applicable data protection legislation and based on the legal ground of legitimate interest under Article 6.1(f) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). As the data controller, Stockholms studentbostäder has a legitimate interest in processing personal data in order to guarantee the physical safety of its employees, tenants, and visitors. The processing of personal data is also necessary to prevent crime and vandalism. Stockholms studentbostäder’s legitimate interest in these matters outweighs the individuals’ interest and need for privacy protection.

Categories of Personal Data

Personal data covered by camera surveillance consists of recorded footage of movements in the areas where cameras have been installed for the purposes stated above.

Access to Data from Camera Surveillance

Access to recorded material is limited to authorized personnel at Stockholms studentbostäder.

The recorded material may also be processed by authorized personnel at Stockholms studentbostäder’s data processors, i.e. companies engaged by Stockholms studentbostäder for security and surveillance services as well as for the operation of camera surveillance systems.

The recorded material may also be processed by the police where legal grounds for such processing exist.

How Long is the Recorded Material Stored?

Recorded material is stored for a maximum of 14 days. The material may be stored for a longer period if necessary to comply with specific legal requirements or if the material constitutes evidence in legal proceedings. In such cases, the material is deleted as soon as the purpose for its storage ceases.

Storage of Specific Recordings and Events

As part of a police report or an ongoing police investigation, Stockholms studentbostäder may need to secure evidence material to be transferred to the police. When we store and transfer personal data to the police as part of a police report or preliminary investigation, the processing is based on the legal ground of legal obligation under Article 6.1(c) of the GDPR.

Transfer to Third Countries

The recorded material is not transferred outside the EU/EEA.

Camera Surveillance and Individual Rights

Stockholms studentbostäder complies with applicable data protection legislation. If it is perceived that the camera surveillance carried out is in violation of the rules of the GDPR, a complaint can be filed with the Swedish Authority for Privacy Protection (Integritetsskyddsmyndigheten, IMY). Individuals present in properties under Stockholms studentbostäder's camera surveillance may appear on film. Those who may appear on film are entitled, upon request, to the following extended rights:

- Confirmation from Stockholms studentbostäder of whether or not they appear on film.
- Information from Stockholms studentbostäder about the purpose of the camera surveillance.
- Information from Stockholms studentbostäder about the storage period.
- Access to the recorded material, to the extent that it concerns the individual.
